# Introduction

#### Welcome

Welcome to the administrator and author hands-on workshop for SAP NetWeaver Cloud portal. Over the next two hours, you will author sites, apply themes, manage content and users and experience immediate results of your work. After this session, you will be equipped with the knowledge and skills to quickly author and administer your own sites using NetWeaver Cloud Portal.

#### Workshop Agenda

This workshop is structured into 7 exercises, as follows:

### 1. ADD NEW WIDGETS

In this exercise you, as a tenant administrator, will learn how to manage available widgets in the content catalog available to the site authors.

### 2. DEFINE CLOUD PORTAL USERS

In this exercise you, as a tenant operator, will learn how to assign users to the global cloud portal roles.

### 3. AUTHOR SITE

In this exercise you, as a site creator and site author, will learn how to create and author new site

#### 4. CONFIGURE AND PUBLISH THE SITE

In this exercise you, as a site author, will learn how to configure and publish the site to the end users.

### 5. USE ADVANCED AUTHORING FEATURES

In this exercise you, as a site author, will learn how to make one-pager sites, alternate widget configuration for device consumption, preview with tablet view.

#### 6. MANAGE THEMES

In this exercise you, as a site author, will learn how to apply themes to the site to alternate its visual properties. You will also learn, as a tenant administrator, how to change default theme.

### 7. USE ADVANCED SITE MANAGEMENT CAPABILITIES

In this exercise you, as a site author, will learn how to manage site lifecycle, including revert site to last published, take the site off and remove site.

### TERMINOLOGY

Account

An entity of SAP NetWeaver Cloud where customers may develop their own apps and connect to other apps and services like SAP NetWeaver Cloud Portal

Tenant	Entity under account where applications are assigned and configuration is stored	
Application	Web application running on NetWeaver Cloud. Can be application developed by customer within customer's account or application provided by SAP or 3 <sup>rd</sup> party vendor. Application is assigned to the tenant	
Site Creator role	User assigned to this role may create sites	
Cloud Portal Administrator role	Users assigned to this role may assign roles to other users, manage widgets and themes, create and author all sites	
Site Owner role	This role is per site and allows assigned users to manage particular site	
Site End User	This role is per site and allows assigned users to use the site	
Widget	Open Social or URL based component in Content Catalog and on the site	
Content Catalog	Repository and UI component where site owner can find content and add to his site	
Theme	CSS file that can be uploaded by portal administrator and selected by site author, which allows to control visual representation of the site

Create a Site in 10 Easy Steps × Your entry point to the SAP NetWeaver Cloud Portal is the Site Directory. This is where you can see all your sites, and create new ones. Give your site a name and choose "Open Site for Editing" to go to the Authoring Space. Now add pages to your site by choosing + in the page navigation bar. You can rename pages or delete them, as required. To display the some menu for accessing the page options, hover the cursor over the page name. Add content to the page. In the side-panel menu, choose 🛃 to open the content catalog. This is where you will find all the widgets that you can add to your site. To add a widget to the page, you can either double-click it to add it to the bottom of the page, or drag it from the catalog directly to its position. Finalize the look of your page: · Move widgets around on the page to position them. Resize widgets by dragging their right or lower side. · Rename widgets by double-clicking the title and typing a new name. • Some widgets on the page may be better viewed in full-screen mode. First make sure that there are no other widgets on the page. Then, hover the cursor over the header area of a widget, choose 🍳 to open the Options menu, and choose Set as Full Page. • To remove a widget from the page, hover the cursor over the header area, choose 💁 to open the Options menu, and choose "Remove". Select a theme for the site by choosing 20 in the side-panel menu, selecting one of the provided themes, and choosing Apply Theme. When you are satisfied with the site, you can check to see what it will look like on a tablet device. Choose 🔲 to simulate what the site will look like to an end user. Give your users access to the site by sending them invitations to use it. Choose 🕅 in the side-panel menu, and select Invite Users. Enter the full e-mail addresses of all users to whom you want to grant access, and write a few introductory words about the site that you are inviting them to view. The invitations will be sent only after you publish the site first time.
